



Just like those moments of having food in your teeth, a wardrobe malfunction, realizing you are in the wrong class, getting someone's name wrong, or locking your keys in your car—there are 'embarrassing' design issues that are often discovered in coordination. Wouldn't it be good to find/prevent some of these before drawings are issued for construction?

This presentation/discussion will focus on various ideas the design team can do to ensure their project will transition smoothly to construction coordination (a unicorn). Looking at some anonymous case studies, we will discuss some minor modeling adjustments and work-flows for reviewing a project that can be done during the SD and DD phases.
